



The PCC of Witney have made the decision to open the doors of our Churches for some services, from Sunday 13th September.

Our current plan is that there will be one or two services on a Sunday across our churches, and a weekly Eucharist on Wednesday, also across our churches. We intend that some of the services will be outdoors. These services will be Eucharistic with short intercessions and no sermon. Due to current guidelines it will not be possible to have congregational singing at these services. It is intended that our 10.30am service on Zoom will remain the central focus in our worship.

We will supply a rota so you are clear where the services will be conducted. People will be asked to book a ticket in advance through the Parish Office, with a very few spaces left for those who turn up on the day. Facemasks will need to be worn in churches, unless exempt under Government guidelines.

We currently have agreed risk assessments for Saint Mary's, Hailey and Holy Trinity; these are required before a church is able to re-open.

We will need to be responsive as to how we adjust this – guided by the Government, and the Diocese.

Please continue to pray for the developing situation and for the Ministry Team, wardens and others involved.
